BEAUTY LESSON ON CONCEALERS

They are the holy grail of any make-up kit but can ruin your entire look if not used right. Some lessons I've learnt over the years...

Set it
For the longest time, I didn't appreciate dusting some translucent powder on the areas concealed. I soon realised a light dab of powder not only helps settle in the concealer, but also keeps it intact for longer.
Pro tip: Make sure you use a eye shadow or concealer brush for the powder. This will help you perfectly cover blemishes.



Different concealers, different uses
The limitless options are confusing, but here's an easy tip to remember. Pen formulas and liquids concealers are perfect for under the eyes. They are easy to apply and balance the under-eye area better. Solid concealers are best used on scars, blemishes or to hide acne.



Before or after foundation?
It's mostly a personal preference, but I recommend applying the concealer after your BB cream or foundation. Simply because if you apply it before, then it may smudge or spread and you'd have to reapply it.



Go easy with skin under the eyes



Never, never, never pull the skin under your eye or roughly scrub through. It's the most delicate part of your skin and wrinkles easily. To avoid crow's feet and wrinkles, settle the under-eye concealer by dabbing.



Brush vs fingers
Like there are different concealers for different uses, you should choose which one to apply how - using fingertips or with a brush. Fingers work best for your area under the eyes. Use a concealer brush to lighten your scars and hide acne.
